,
Even when we are under fire there is a way to move through the attack and into blessing and anointing
ATTACK———
Men are under spiritual attack:
At home
At work
-
At play
p.m.,

Philippians 3:8 "... I consider everything as loss..."

Attacks cripple us because we find our value in their outcome
Where does your value lie?
How do you know your worth?

We cannot live a life that is devoid of attacks:

Paul tells Timothy that even though he leads a good life with good intent he (Paul) has still dealt with suffering. If we cannot live a life without attack then we must find a way to deal with it (2 Tim 3:10-12)



Digression: The Language of Love Words of Affirmation Compliments
Quality Time Undivided attention
Gifts Doesn't have to be a lot
Acts of Service Time, creativity, chores.
Physical Touch

This is usually how we find value. Through the knowledge that people love/care for us.

Though helpful in daily life, our value cannot come from this, but only from God

Philippians 3:8 "... I consider everything as loss..."

Words of Destruction

do you use "unfair" words in fights with spouse or friends?

Hiding Away

seeking out the "man cave" unfairly or for unreasonable amounts of time

Being Overly Materialistic

"can't buy my love" need not apply

Demanding Acts

depending too much on others, or having demands that must be met to meet our needs

Abuse

Our reaction affects all other aspects of our lives.

God is able to take the TRIAL and change it into a TRAINING

Job

- Was tested, destroyed, and nearly undone
- Had a support group that didn't support



Many trials have the "Jesus Pattern"

Friday Trial

Saturday Nothing/Silence

Sunday Resurrection/Victory

Just like Job we need faithfulness
at the heart of our struggle
Why wait 10 years to see what some people means for evil
God uses for Good?

Our Reaction to the attack, to the offense, defines who we are and how we will accept the kingdom.

God isn't looking for the offenders, he's looking for us.

CRT OUT
Are men comfortable with Crying out? What is the consequence as a man when we cry out?
How is this in some ways the "Lost Generation"?

Don't fall into the "toughen up" mythology

ROMANS 14:13-17 "WE MUST STOP JUDGING OTHERS..."

There is a great difference between accountability and persecution and judgment

- God alone has the power to judge
- Paul asks in Romans that our actions be guided by love
- Even what God has ordered us to do is suspect(in context)

Crying out allows us to be accountable.

We are instructed to cry out, and we are instructed on how to react to the one who is crying out.

Crying out is an integral part of this process.

What are some ways you are being attacked right now in life?

How do you deal with attack what is your Hate Reaction? Is that healthy for you, or others? Is it ok to cry out? How do you make time/availability to cry out? Which of the love languages speaks to you?

Breakout Group

How could your family, your small group, or your church aide you in dealing with attack?

PRAY TOGETHER

(suggestion) Heavenly Father, allow us to realize that we can cry out to you. That the strongest biblical fathers have done it, that men of faith rely on you as their only strength. Remind us we don't have to do anything alone. Temper our reaction so that they don't hurt people we love, or hurt ourselves who were created to resemble you. Help us become cornerstones in our church for your will there. Remind us daily where our worth comes from. In Christ name, Amen.

FORGIVENESS I

Forgiveness is two part. God's Forgiveness and Your Forgiveness

Forgiveness sometimes is a matter of truly understanding that it was not your fault

PSALM 18:16-19 "HE RESCUED ME FROM MY POWERFUL ENEMY. FROM MY FOES, WHO WERE TOO STRONG FOR ME."

You need to believe that the kingdom is coming.

Forgiveness is the open doorway to what is coming; too often we get trapped in space after we are forgiven





Anointing Means...

To chose, to consecrate/make sacred, to designate

God's reaction to all of this, the response, is an anointing

- When the people cried out for deliverance God heard them.
 They were living well in Egypt, then they were persecuted,
 then they were freed.
- When the people cried out for a leader, God brought Saul and then David who was called a man after God's own heart.
- And when the nations were crying out for a savior God brought Christ.

Assembly 2a - Seeking

Following the path to anointing only makes it possible for us to receive. Unlocking the anointing is giving power to the call.

RELEASING THE ANOINTING:

Requires Sacrifice

- My son, My only son...
- Being the sacrificial head

Eph 5:23 "The husband is the head of the wife, as Christ is the head of the church." Husband wife is a living picture of the relationship between Christ and the church

[wife] **Helper**, which is worthy - Gen 2:18 "...I will make a helper suitable for him.", Psalm 54:4 "God is my helper, the Lord is the sustainer of my soul."

HEBREWS 11:13-16

"... THEY STILL HAD FAITH, EVEN THOUGH THEY HAD NOT RECEIVED WHAT THEY HAD BEEN PROMISED. THEY WERE GLAD TO SEE THESE THINGS FROM FAR OFF. THEY AGREED THAT THEY WERE ONLY STRANGERS AND FOREIGNERS ON THIS EARTH. WHEN PEOPLE TALK THIS WAY IT IS CLEAR THAT THEY ARE LOOKING FOR A PLACE TO CALL THEIR OWN. Breakout Group

Do we sometimes muddy the waters surrounding a person's "true" name? Through ridicule or judgment? What is the church's purpose in helping us place our "one thing" on the altar in worship?

PRAY TOGETHER

(suggestion) God, you ask that we have only you in the center of our hearts, and you warn us that you are a jealous God. Teach us to claim you there, even though the lesson might be hard, we trust you enough to ask it even still. Remind us of the name you gave us, and strengthen us to adhere to its meaning. Amen.

Assembly 2b Seeking

We have gone from being *under fire* in attacks, to being *Under the Fire* of the Holy Spirit

Let's go from King Seeking the King, to Seeing the that lies within us...

Men have a particular spiritual focus in God's kingdom. They are the head. They are Kings of what God, the King of Kings has put before us.

Martin Luther called Christians "little Christs"

Our anointing is what comes before our ministry, our rule, our action as king.



If we work through our attacks, or hear a call it's like God gave us the keys to the family car.

The anointing is the gas that goes in it.

Are you on the road out of gas?

The Queen of Sheba...

1 Kings 10:9 "Praise be to your God who has delighted in you and placed you on the throne of Israel. Because of the Lord's eternal love for Israel he has made you king to rule with justice and righteousness."

SEE KING ——

Biblical Kings were stewards with whom God entrusted his kingdom.

Steward of Gondor...

We are **responsible** for the corruption or decline of our churches and families.

Our failure can come because we are accepting the kingship and the power without accepting the stewardship.

Saruman and Gandalf...

Mo's Temper Dave's Desires

The Good King does what?
Love Like a Savior - An act of will, Sacrificial, given in obedience to Christ not in response to performance, Love's goal is the building up and enrichment of a wife.
Col 3:19 "Husbands love your wives and do not be embittered against them."

Discuss some ways that this breakout group could continue to hold one another up in glory, and in accountability as we return to our weekly lives at the church.

PRAY TOGETHER

(suggestion) Holy Father, You give us a call. Sometimes several! Sometimes you change our call. We can praise you for giving our lives your purpose, and for teaching us to desire that. You see in each of us a King, a ruler of a small peace of the Emperor's earthly kingdom. Give us your spirit so that we can govern as good stewards. With love, with sacrifice and with caring. Help us create Your will here on this earth. Amen
